

Game Rules Happy Families

Look at the symbols at the top of the cards. This game has 8 families (families A through H). Each family has 4 cards. The object of the game is to collect as many families as possible.

When playing with more than 2 players, deal out all cards equally amongst players. The first player starts by asking another player for a card needed to complete a family. If the player has the card, it needs to be handed over. If the other player doesn't have that specific card, the turn ends and the next player gets to request a card. That player can retake the cards taken in the previous round.

When playing with only 2 players, deal 10 cards to each player and place the rest of the cards face-down on a draw-pile. When the other player

doens't have the card you're asking for, take the top card from the draw-pile.

As soon as a player gathers a complete family, all 4 cards are put face down on the table. The player who collects the most families at the end of the game is the winner!
